



**ORDERED**, that Cheryl Jones, Calvin C. Owens, Harold I. Jackson, Lawrence Myers, Estate of Don Saunders, Janet Hill, Clement Suna, Donna Cotton, and Glenda Hall, are appointed as Class Representatives; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that Wendy L. Kahn and Jordan M. Kaplan of the firm Zwerdling, Paul, Kahn & Wolly, P.C, are appointed Class Counsel; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Proposed Settlement Agreement, as Amended, is preliminarily approved pending further consideration at a Fairness Hearing, to be set by the Court on the date set forth below; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Court preliminarily finds that the terms of the Settlement Agreement, as Amended, including a Class Fund of \$8,100,000 and attorneys' fees and costs of \$900,000, are fair, reasonable, and adequate, and in the best interests of the Class; and it is further


**ORDERED**, that the Court approves the manner by which identified potential Class Members will be notified of the settlement pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement, including the mailing of a Detailed Notice (Exhibit C); notices to be published in at least three local newspapers, including the Express, the Washington Examiner, and the City Paper; a follow-up mailing of a Postcard Notice (Exhibit H), which will be mailed 45 days after the mailing of the Detailed Notice to those identified potential Class Members who received, but did not respond to, the Detailed Notice; and publication of the settlement in the D.C. Bar Magazine and on the website for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, in addition to the websites for the Class Administrator, Class Counsel, the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia, and the Office of Risk Management for the District of Columbia. These proposed notices, the Claim Form (Exhibit A) and other forms, and all deadlines set forth in the Joint Motion, are also approved; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Court also approves the proposed firm of Settlement Services, Inc. as the Class Administrator. It is further

**ORDERED**, that the Class Administrator shall file its report with the Court by no later than February 5, 2016. The parties shall file any objections by no later than February 12, 2016. It is further

**ORDERED**, that the Court will hold a Fairness Hearing on February 19, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 24A.
